

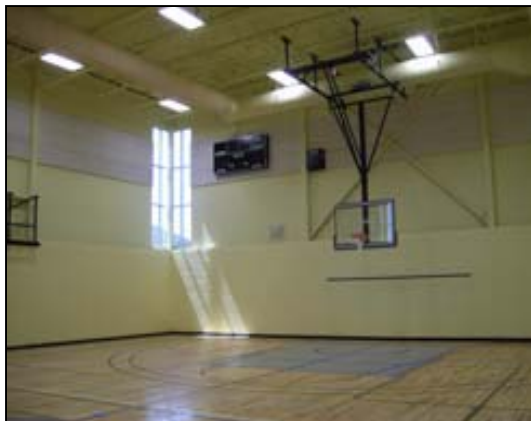
Our Newest Community Centres! (2011 – 2012)

This Power Smart building is seeking LEED Silver certification and has already received the City of Winnipeg's Accessibility Award, earning high marks for its barrier-free design.
