Universal Funding Community Centre Operating Grants Released in February

The grant payments are being processed and in some cases community centres have received their first payment for the year. The 2024 UFF Grant Payment has increased in 2024 by 5.92%.

The funding is now \$4.14 per heated square foot, \$2.28 per capita and \$6,971.00 per rink for the first two rinks on site and \$3,847.00 for any subsequent rink.

ODR Maintenance

A lot of questions are arising concerning the unseasonably mild weather and your Centre's ability to maintain safe and skate-ready outdoor rinks. Obviously, the weather can't be controlled and depending on the forecast in the next few weeks, it may be possible to reopen and maintain the rinks when (or if) the weather becomes favourable to do so. In terms of funding, once information becomes available, we will share it.

2024 Program Fee Subsidy Grant

This funding is available from GCWCC to the Community Centres, please note that the per child, per sport reimbursement has increased to \$400 for a total of \$800 per child per year. The form is available from our office, or by <u>clicking this link to download it</u>.
