Canadian Tire Jumpstart

We were notified by Jumpstart that the program for Winnipeg has changed.

"As we continue to review and evolve Jumpstart programming in response to record demand for funding, we have decided to change the assistance offered in Winnipeg.

Moving forward, we know that we can create the most sustainable and transformative impact in local sport landscapes through Community Development Grants. Through these grants and associated programming, we can help address systemic issues in sport and support communities build a stronger foundation for long-term development.



With this shift, we have discontinued Individual Child Grants in Winnipeg as of January 2024. We understand this decision may be disappointing news, but we strongly believe this is the best course to ensure sustainable and meaningful support for kids."
