Propane Handling and Exchange Certification Course

Gateway Recreation Centre is hosting a Propane Handling and Exchange Certification Course

This course is designed to provide propane operators of powered off-road vehicles with the information necessary with respect to exchanging propane carburation cylinders 33 1/3liquid withdrawal carburation propane cylinders used for engine fuel supply. The course assumes equipment operators will be exchanging cylinders at their employer's location.

There will be both a classroom and practical component to the course. This course includes both a multiple- choice written examination and a practical examination.

Codes and Standards as well as Provincial regulations require that a person working with propane be properly trained with this work. For this course, references are:

CSA B149.2 Propane Storage and Handling and TC-Transportation of Dangerous Goods

Certification is valid for 3 years.

Maximum: 15 participants, 1st pay, 1st serve

Date and Time: Wednesday, November 22, 2023, 9 am to 1 pm
