Manitoba Accessibility Fund

The Manitoba government is calling for applications for grants of up to \$50,000 from the Manitoba Accessibility Fund (MAF) for organizations that will promote accessibility and remove barriers for people with disabilities, Families Minister Rochelle Squires, minister responsible for accessibility, announced.

Deadline to apply is April 15th.

Criminal Record Check Grant

The grant is designed to protect your community centre, all signing authorities should be checked. Additional checks are at the board's discretion.

Child Abuse Registry Checks

As we restart programming at community centres, including sports and camps, remember to ensure anyone working with young children has been cleared with a Child Abuse Registry Check.

Remember doing a CAR check for your volunteers is free, but for the fee to be waived you must submit a Fee Payment Page with every application.

GCWCC is no longer able to do the checks on the community centre's behalf. Community Centres are responsible to get an access number to send in applications on behalf of your volunteers.

If you do not already have your access number, you can email car@gov.mb.ca and they will direct you.
