We're working to remove those barriers and increase girls' engagement in sport and so, we've created the Girls Multi-Sport Series. Young girls deserve a fun introduction to sport, where they learn new skills and have positive experiences that will keep them engaged in and playing sport for life.

The series is free for all participants and designed to allow girls aged 7-12 (split into two groups 7-9 and 10-12) to try different sports, offered by our recognized sport partners. Trying out different sports can help young girls find one that suits their interests and goals.
