Fall Renovation Grant

Congratulations to the Recipients of the Fall Renovation Grant!

The Mayor announced the successful applicants yesterday at Lord Roberts Community Centre, here is the link to the Media Release https://winnipeg.ca/cao/media/news/nr_2021/nr_20211209.stm

As you know the renovation grant was increased to 2 million dollars. In the spring 23 Community Centres received over \$1.8M, and this fall intake 9 Centres received over \$700K.

As a reminder, if you're planning to apply in 2022 for a Renovation Grant (CCRGP), be sure to reach out to Arthur Pearson in advance of the deadline. The deadline for the Spring Intake is March 15th, 2022.

Further Information: Outdoor Rinks Public Health Orders

We were asked if washrooms could be made available for anyone using the outdoor rinks without having to confirming proof of vaccination: the following was provided to us from the Province and the City of Winnipeg:

Associated Indoor Facilities: Proof of immunization is not required to access indoor facilities associated with outdoor sporting facilities, such as washroom access, warming, etc.

Rink Capacity: Per Order 13, outdoor sporting facilities – including rinks – are not restricted to a total capacity of 50 persons. However, individual groups of persons attending at the rink are limited to 50 persons unless all persons can produce proof of vaccination and the number of spectators cannot exceed 50% of the usual spectator capacity.

Program Registration Fee Subsidy Grant:

At the last GCWCC board meeting, December 6th, we presented ways to streamline the current Subsidy Grant application. We've asked the District Reps to share the information at the next CCB meetings. We're collecting feedback from Centres before we finalize the new application.

The new application would be available for the Spring Registration, February 2022.
